

#### ONE LIFE (12A)

The extraordinary Anthony Hopkins leads this emotionally stirring biographical drama, profiling the inspirational story of Nicholas Winton, a World War II hero who saved hundreds of Jewish children from occupied Europe. One Life boasts a tremendous supporting cast which includes Helena Bonham Carter (The Crown), Samantha Spiro (London Spy) and Jonathan Pryce (The Two Popes).



## THE MARVELS (12A)

Carol Danvers aka Captain Marvel has reclaimed her identity from the tyrannical Kree and taken revenge on the Supreme Intelligence. When her duties send her to an anomalous wormhole linked to a Kree revolutionary, her powers become entangled with that of Jersey City superfan, Kamala Khan aka Ms. Marvel, and Carol's estranged niece, now S.A.B.E.R. astronaut Captain Monica Rambeau. #### **GODZILLA MINUS ONE (15)**

#### MONICA (15)

#### POOR THINGS (18)

From filmmaker Yorgos Lanthimos (The Favourite) and producer Emma Stone comes the incredible tale and fantastical evolution of Bella Baxter (Stone), a young woman brought back to life by the brilliant and unorthodox scientist Dr. Godwin Baxter (Dafoe).
Bella is thrown into the stifling confines of Victorian England – and immediately eager to learn what lies beyond it. With the help of a roguish lawyer (Mark Ruffalo), Bella runs away on a whirlwind tour of the world to satiate her plentiful desires, and discovers precisely what liberation means.



### **AQUAMAN AND THE LOST KINGDOM (12A)**

#### FRIGHT NIGHT: RAGING GRACE (15)

Stuck in a roundabout of precarious employment, deportation fears and casual, constant put-downs by her employers, Joy cannot afford to stand still. A dreamy gig looking after a mansion and its bed-bound owner (David Hayman) turns out to be too-good-to-be-true when Joy starts suspecting the owner is being slowly poisoned.



### CLÉO FROM 5 TO 7 (PG)

Agnès Varda eloquently captures Paris in the sixties with this real-time portrait of a singer (Corinne Marchand) set adrift in the city as she awaits test results of a biopsy. A chronicle of the minutes of one woman's life, Cléo from 5 to 7 is a spirited mix of vivid vérité and melodrama, featuring a score by Michel Legrand (The Umbrellas of Cherbourg) and cameos by Jean-Luc Godard and Anna Karina.
