

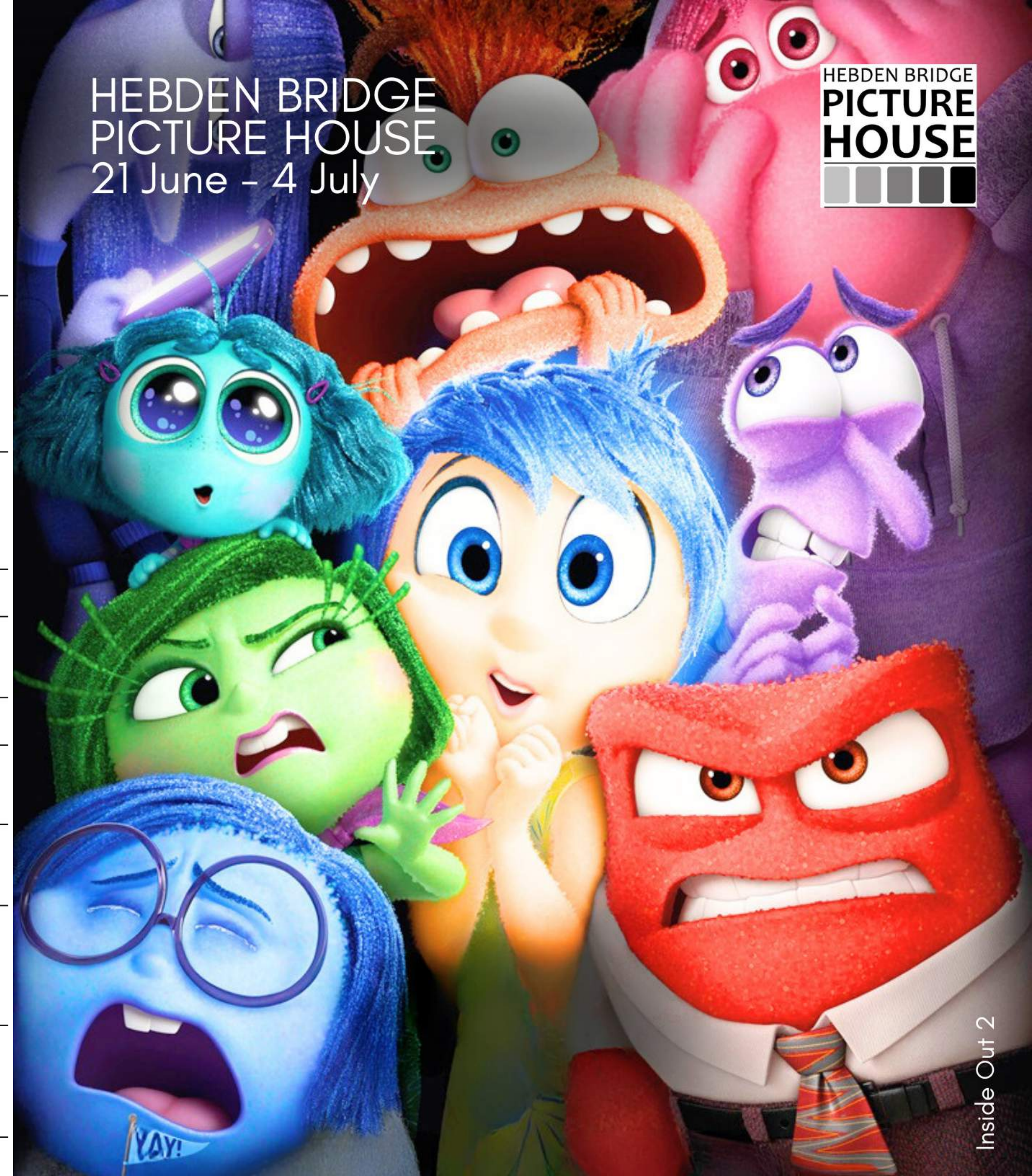

## THE BIKERIDERS (15)

Austin Butler, Michael Shannon, Jodie Comer and Tom Hardy lead an all-star ensemble cast in The Bikeriders, the latest from writer-director Jeff Nichols. An exhilarating, full-throttle period drama, it's derived from Danny Lyon's 1967 photography study of bikers in the Midwest and pays clear tribute to classic films (The Wild One, Easy Rider) exploiting the iconic mid-century cool of the motorbike as a potent and very American symbol of individual freedom.



## HARRY POTTER AND THE PRISONER OF AZKABAN (PG) 20TH ANNIVERSARY

Re-live the magical moments of Harry Potter And The Prisoner Of Azkaban on the big screen. Harry, Ron and Hermione return as teenagers for a third term at Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry. But Harry's fate, and that of the entire community of wizards, looks bleak when the infamous Sirius Black escapes from prison.

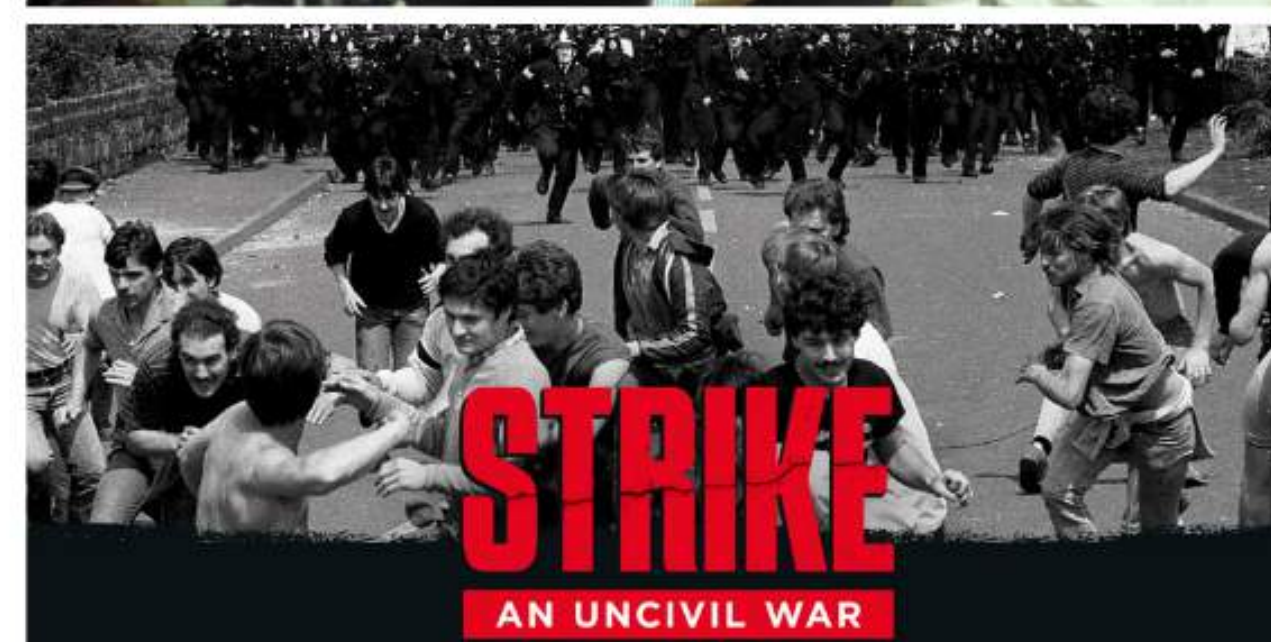
## THE DEAD DON'T HURT (15)

In a frontier town run by corrupt forces, fiercely independent Vivienne Le Coudy (Vicky Krieps) embarks on a relationship with the passionate, hard-working Holger Olsen (Viggo Mortensen) but it's one that leads to danger for them both. With the threat of the Civil War looming, their future becomes uncertain when Holger decides to fight for the Union, leaving Vivienne on her own to face the dangerous threats of the corrupt mayor, the power-hungry ranch owner and the rancher's violent son.



## NETWORK (15) - SIDNEY LUMET CENTENARY

Howard Beale, a veteran newscaster, is informed by his ratings-driven network executives that he is about to be dumped because he "skews old" - in turn, he uses his next broadcast to announce that he is going to commit suicide on his final programme. An ambitious programming executive convinces her superiors to let the broadcast go ahead, hoping that the final event will give the network its greatest ratings ever.



## STRIKE: AN UNCIVIL WAR (15)

Daniel Gordon's feature documentary STRIKE: AN UNCIVIL WAR tells the story of the Battle of Orgreave, the most violent confrontation between Miners and Police during the 1984/85 Miners' Strike in Great Britain. Witness at first hand the stories and recollections of the people on the front lines of this incredible moment in time, which split communities and the nation in two, and which has ripples that still resonate to this very day.



## ZORBA THE GREEK (PG) In Greek and English with English subtitles.

Zorba the Greek is filled with humour, pathos, tears, and joy—a classic. With outstanding performances (Bates, Quinn, Lila Kedrova, Irene Papas), black-and-white cinematography, faces of the people of Crete, and the music of Mikis Theodorakis, Zorba is lasting cinema that can be enjoyed today. Winner of three Academy Awards and nominated for seven, including three for prominent Greek-Cypriot director Michael Cacoyannis.
