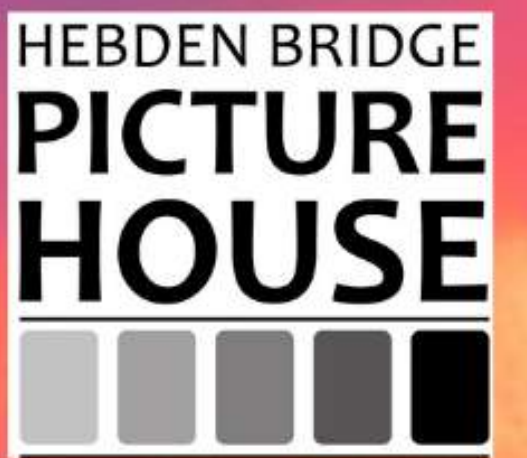

Gru (Oscar nominee Steve Carrell) and Lucy (Oscar nominee Kristen Wiig) and their girls – Margo, Edith and Agnes – welcome a new member to the Gru family, Gru Jr., who is intent on tormenting his dad. Gru faces a new nemesis in Maxime Le Mal (Emmy winner Will Ferrell) and his femme fatale girlfriend Valentina (Emmy nominee Sofia Vergara), and the family is forced to go on the run.



BLUR: TO THE END (15)

blur: To The End follows the unique relationship of four friends – and band mates of three decades – Damon Albarn, Graham Coxon, Alex James and Dave Rowntree, as they come together to record new songs ahead of their sold-out, first ever shows at London's Wembley Stadium in 2023. Featuring performances of their most iconic, much-loved songs, footage of the band in the studio and life on the road, this film is an intimate moment in time with this most enduring of English bands.

Hot on the heels of Oscar favourite Poor Things, filmmaker extraordinaire Yorgos Lanthimos reunites with Best Actress-winning Emma Stone for their exhilarating third feature collaboration. Featuring a staggering supporting cast which includes Willem Dafoe, Margaret Qualley, Jesse Plemons and Hong Chau, this deliciously dark tantalising trilogy of tales is one of the hottest cinematic tickets of the year.



HAPPY VALLEY PRIDE PRESENTS: DESERT HEARTS (18)

In a rare screening on a new print, this 1950s set love story remains one of the most sensual and beautifully shot lesbian films of all time and will be introduced by the BFI's Head Librarian, Emma Smart. Donna Deitch's luscious romantic drama follows the uptight professor Vivian who arrives in Nevada in 1959 to legalise her divorce. There she meets the free-spirited Cay, who works in the casinos where she fends off the advances of men and seduces women.



FOREST GUMP (12A) 30TH ANNIVERSARY

Slow-witted Forrest Gump (Tom Hanks) has never thought of himself as disadvantaged, and thanks to his supportive mother (Sally Field), he leads anything but a restricted life. Whether dominating on the gridiron as a college football star, fighting in Vietnam or captaining a shrimp boat, Forrest inspires people with his childlike optimism. But one person Forrest cares about most may be the most difficult to save – his childhood love, the sweet but troubled Jenny (Robin Wright).

WILDING (PG)

Based on Isabella Tree's best-selling book by the same title, Wilding tells the story of a young couple that bets on nature for the future of their failing, four-hundred-year-old estate. Ripping down the fences, they set the land back to the wild and entrust its recovery to a motley mix of animals both tame and wild. It is the beginning of a grand experiment that will become one of the most significant rewilding experiments in Europe.
