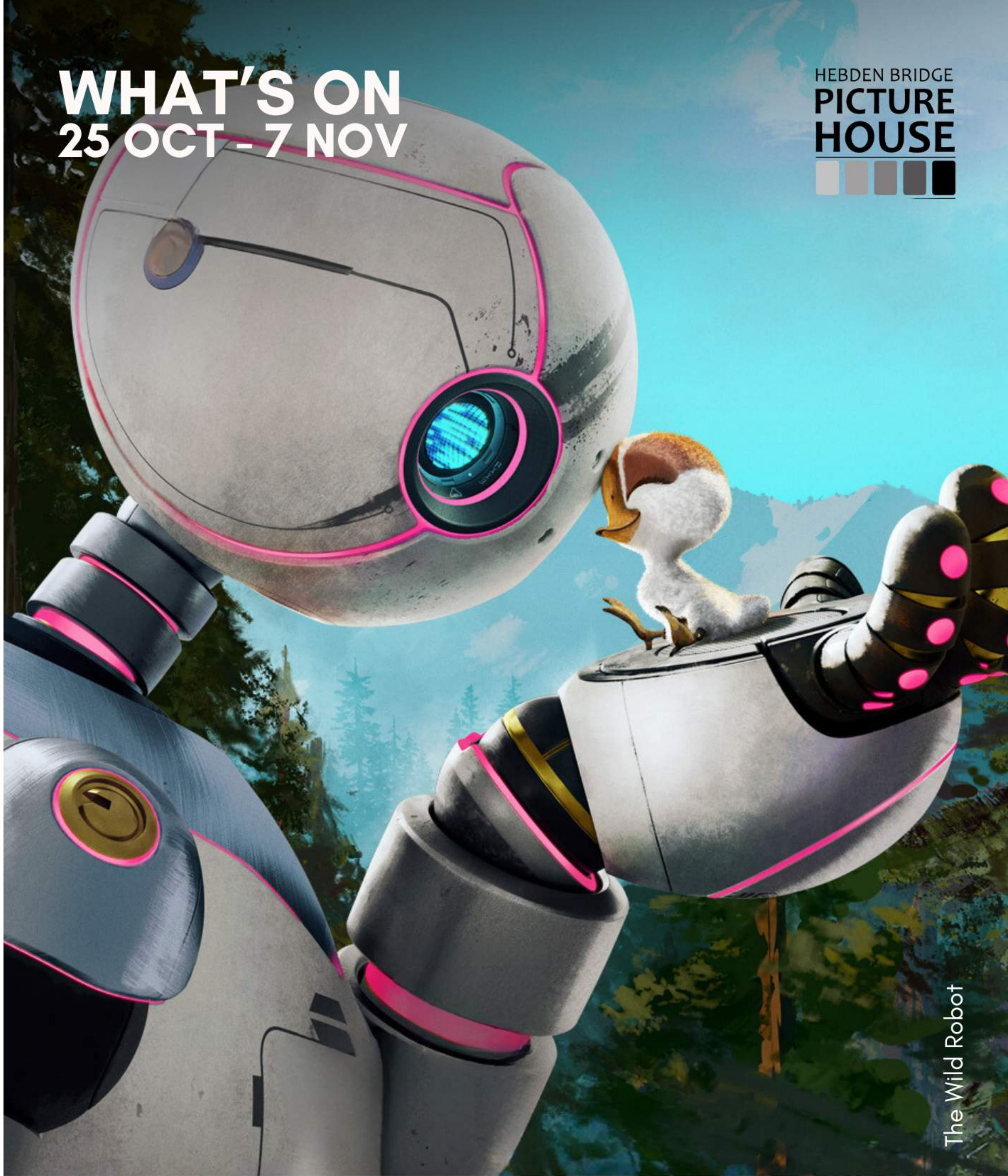

THE WILD ROBOT (U)

The Wild Robot follows Roz, a futuristic robot that washes ashore on a deserted island. A tale of survival and discovery begins when she becomes the unexpected protector to an orphaned gosling. Together they struggle to survive the harsh environment, but only succeed with the help of a close-knit group of misfit animals, who first become friends, then family.



STARVE ACRE (15) WITH WRITER Q&A

Matt Smith (Doctor Who) and Morfydd Clark (Saint Maud) star in this creepy and stylish adaptation of Andrew Michael Hurley's 2019 novel of the same name. In 1970s rural Yorkshire, Richard and Juliette Willoughby's seemingly idyllic family life is thrown into turmoil when their young son Owen starts acting out of character.



LEE (15)

Lee tells the story of Lee Miller, American photographer. Determined to document the truth of the Nazi regime, and in spite of the odds stacked against female correspondents, Lee captured some of the most important images of World War II. CARRIE (15) - 4K RESTORATION

You're all invited to the Bates High School Prom! Based on the novel by Stephen King, Brian De Palma's celebrated shocker blends romance and horror, starring Sissy Spacek as a bullied teenager with telekinetic powers who wreaks bloody revenge on peers and parents.



RBO: WOLF WITCH GIANT FAIRY (PG)

HALLOWEEN (15) - 4K RESTORATION

Deliriously entertaining and ruthlessly satirical, Coralie Fargeat's Cannes sensation turns toxic beauty culture inside out with a be-careful-what-you-wish-for fable for the ages. Explosive, provocative and twisted, *The Substance* marks the arrival of a thrillingly visionary filmmaker.



THE TEACHER (12A)

From Academy Award nominated and BAFTA-award winning British-Palestinian director, Farah Nabulsi, *The Teacher* follows a Palestinian school teacher who struggles to reconcile his risky commitment to political resistance with his emotional support for one of his students and the chance of a new relationship with a volunteer worker.
