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## MOANA 2 (PG)

*Moana 2* is the thrilling sequel to Disney's beloved 2016 animated musical. Accompanied by the ever-powerful demigod Maui and a fresh crew of unlikely seafarers, Moana embarks on a journey deep into the far seas of Oceania. Their mission: to break an ancient curse that threatens a long-lost island once vital to her ancestors. Along the way, Moana and her companions must face dangerous waters, hidden islands, and mysterious foes – including a formidable sea monster.



## HERETIC (15)

Two young missionaries (Sophie Thatcher and Chloe East) are forced to prove their faith when they step into the household of the diabolical Mr. Reed (Hugh Grant), becoming ensnared in his deadly game of cat-and-mouse. Playing against type in the most devilish way imaginable, Hugh Grant delivers a career-best turn of unrelenting menace. The latest film from the creative minds behind *A Quiet Place*, Scott Beck and Bryan Woods, this is a nightmarish religious horror you won't want to escape from.



## JUROR #2 (12A)

Nicholas Hoult (*The Favourite*) leads this Clint Eastwood legal drama as a juror on a high profile murder trial. As the case unfolds, Justin realises that he may have been responsible for the victim's death in a reckless driving accident. This discovery forces him into a moral dilemma: should he use his knowledge to sway the jury's verdict and protect himself, or let an innocent person face conviction? Kemp's struggle between justice and self-preservation is at the heart of this tense thriller. Also starring Toni Collette, J.K. Simmons and Kiefer Sutherland.



## ALL WE IMAGINE AS LIGHT (15)

Prabha, Anu and Parvati are employees at a hospital in Mumbai. They grapple daily with the opportunities and hardships of existence in the city. Balancing an immersive verité style with a touch of the surreal, Payal Kapadia's Cannes Grand Prix-winning drama captures the many shades of working-class life in Mumbai. The result is a profound and deeply humanist meditation on urban migration and dislocation.

## WICKED (PG)

*Wicked* makes its long-awaited journey to the big screen as a spectacular, generation-defining cinematic event this holiday season. *Wicked*, the untold story of the witches of Oz, stars Emmy, Grammy and Tony winning powerhouse Cynthia Erivo as Elphaba, a young woman, misunderstood because of her unusual green skin, who has yet to discover her true power, and Grammy-winning, multi-platinum recording artist and global superstar Ariana Grande as Glinda, a popular young woman, gilded by privilege and ambition, who has yet to discover her true heart.



## CONCLAVE (12A)

*Conclave* follows one of the world's most secretive and ancient events – selecting the new Pope. Cardinal Lawrence (Ralph Fiennes) is tasked with running this covert process after the unexpected death of the beloved Pope.
