DOG MAN (U)

From DreamWorks Animation, creators of the beloved blockbuster franchises Kung Fu Panda, How to Train Your Dragon and The Boss Baby, comes the canine-crime-fighting film adaptation of Dav Pilkey's New York Times bestselling literary phenomenon: Dog Man. When a faithful police dog and his human police officer owner are injured together on the job, a harebrained but life-saving surgery fuses the two of them together and Dog Man is born. Dog Man is sworn to protect and serve - and fetch, sit and roll over.

THE BRUTALIST (18)

On his own in a strange new country, László settles in Pennsylvania, where the wealthy and prominent industrialist Harrison Lee Van Buren recognizes his talent for building. A REAL PAIN (15)

Jesse Eisenberg (The Social Network) and Kieran Culkin (Succession) are mismatched Jewish American cousins who travel to Europe in an attempt to honour the memory of their late grandmother and reconnect with their heritage. Joined by an eclectic group of fellow Jewish travellers and an overly enthusiastic British tour guide (played brilliantly here by Will Sharpe), they quickly form an unusually close bond and camaraderie.

After a painful breakup, Clementine (Kate Winslet) undergoes an experimental procedure to erase memories of her former boyfriend Joel (Jim Carrey) from her mind. When Joel discovers that Clementine has done so, he sets out to do the same - but as he watches his memories of the woman he loved slowly begin to disappear, he realises what he really wants is to get her back.
