A MINECRAFT MOVIE (PG)

Welcome to the world of Minecraft, where creativity doesn't just help you craft, it's essential to one's survival! Four misfits - Garrett "The Garbage Man" Garrison, Henry, Natalie and Dawn - find themselves struggling with ordinary problems when they are suddenly pulled through a mysterious portal into the Overworld: a bizarre, cubic wonderland that thrives on imagination.



BLACK BAG (15)

THE UMBRELLAS OF CHERBOURG (PG)

Jacques Demy's all-sung tale of first love is a ravishing mix of music, romance and fertile cinematic invention. Deneuve plays an umbrella-shop owner's delicate daughter, glowing with first love for a handsome garage mechanic, played by Nino Castelnuovo. When the boy is shipped off to fight in Algeria, the two lovers must grow up quickly. THE END (12A)

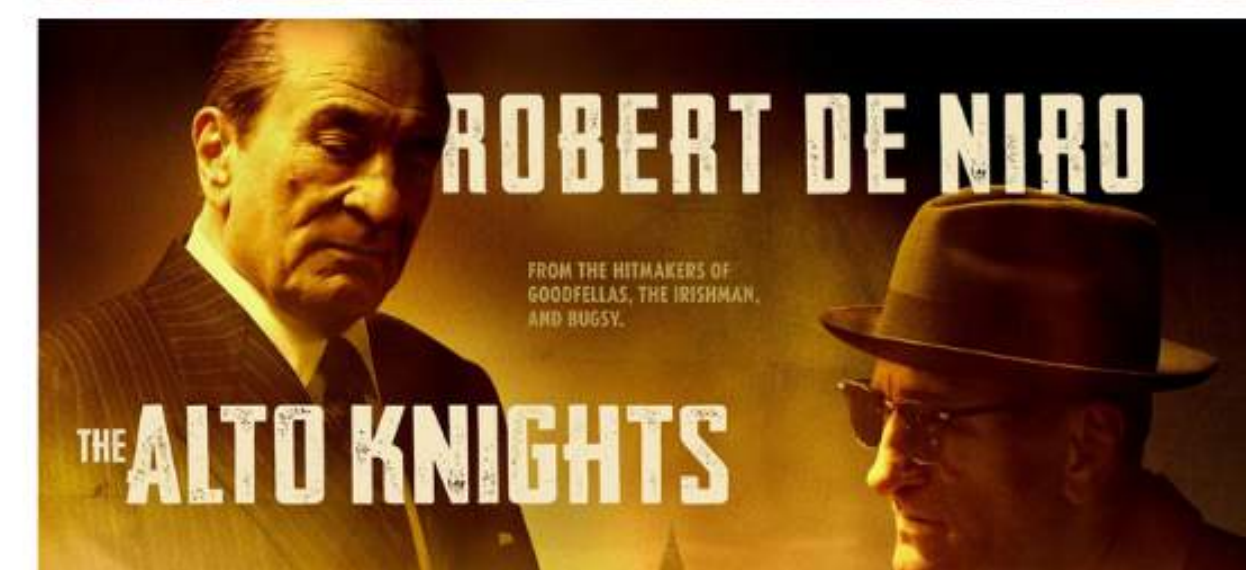

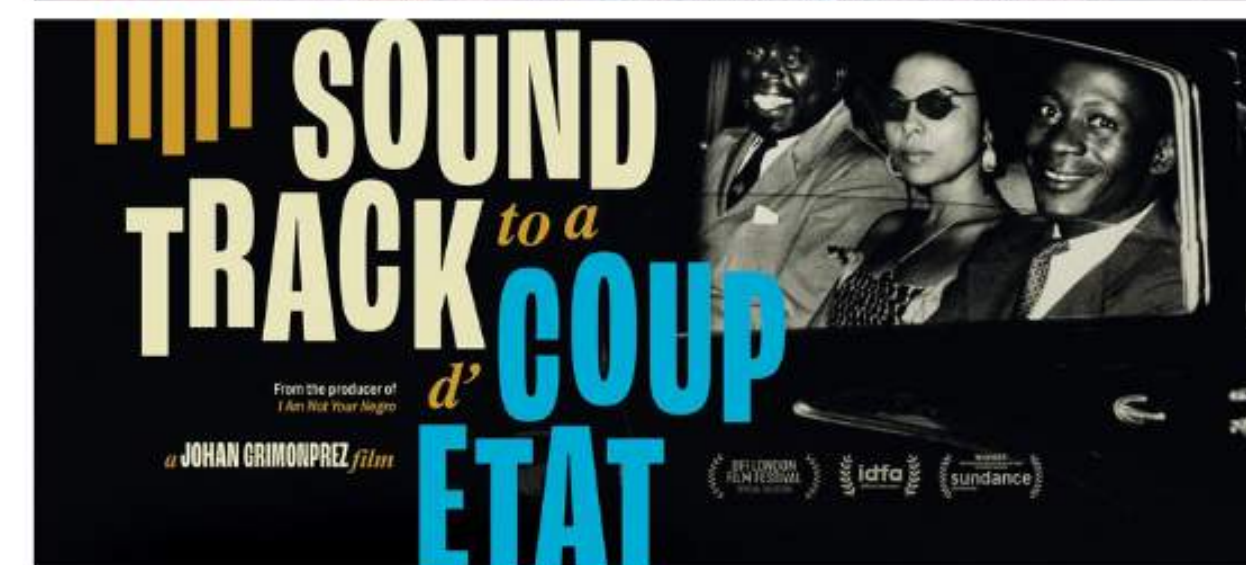
THE ALTO KNIGHTS (15)

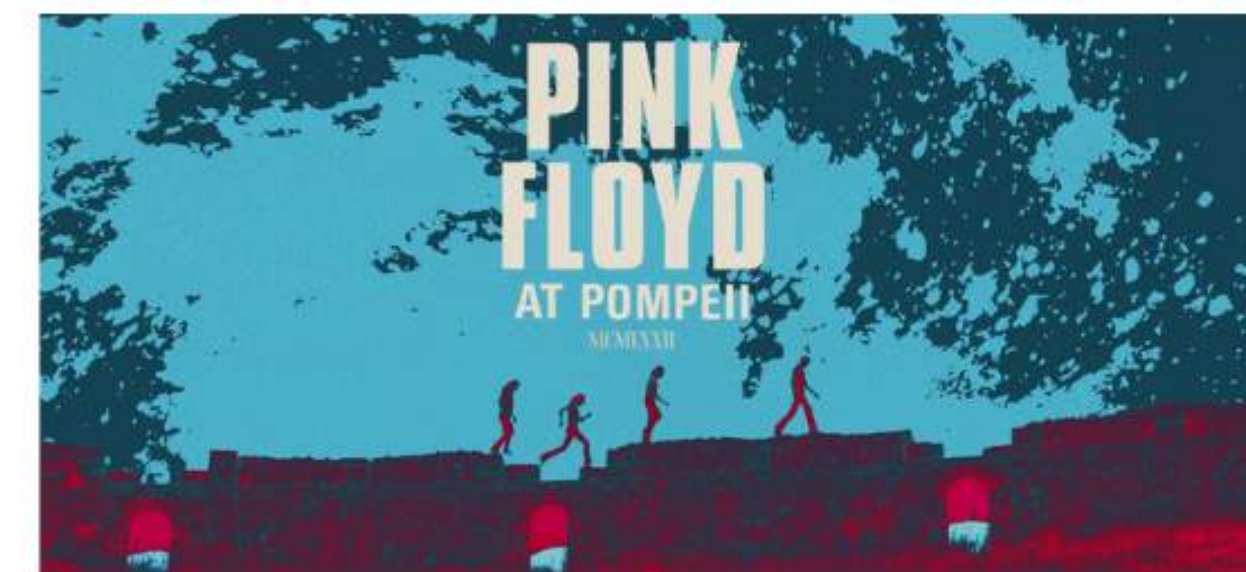
FREE! WILLY WONKA AND THE CHOCOLATE FACTORY (U)
