THE BAD GUYS 2 (U)

Everyone's favourite felons are back, and this time, they have company. In the new action-packed chapter from DreamWorks Animation's acclaimed comedy smash about a crackerjack crew of animal outlaws, our now-reformed Bad Guys are trying (very, very hard) to be good, but instead find themselves hijacked into a high-stakes, globe-trotting heist, masterminded by a new team of criminals they never saw coming: The Bad Girls.



JURASSIC WORLD: REBIRTH (12A)

Five years after the events of Jurassic World Dominion, the planet's ecology has proven largely inhospitable to dinosaurs. Those remaining exist in isolated equatorial environments with climates resembling the one in which they once thrived. The three most colossal creatures within that tropical biosphere hold the key to a drug that will bring miraculous life-saving benefits to humankind.



PIONEERING WOMEN: THE MANCHESTER CORINTHIANS (U)

Join author Gary James in a celebration of the Manchester Corinthians, a women's football club that toured the world during the 1950s to 1980s. Established in 1948-49 these pioneering women played at a time when an FA ban on women's football was in place, winning trophies in major tournaments across Europe and South America.



MY BEAUTIFUL LAUNDRETTE (15) - 40TH ANNIVERSARY

This year marks the 40th anniversary of one of the biggest British films of the 1980s, which helped to launch both the careers of its star Daniel Day Lewis and director Stephen Frears. The film tells the love story of young Pakistani man Omar and his childhood friend turned lover, white ex-skinhead Johnny. Set against the backdrop of racism, homophobia and Thatcherism, the film charts the pair's attempts to renovate a South London laundrette.



FOUR LETTERS OF LOVE (12A)

Pierce Brosnan, Helena Bonham Carter and Gabriel Byrne lead this heart swelling adaptation of Niall Williams' beloved romantic novel, threading together the star-crossed love story of Nicholas and Isabel across the plains of Ireland. HARVEST (18)

The latest feature from celebrated filmmaker Athina Rachel Tsangari (Chevalier, Attenberg), HARVEST is a spellbinding and thrillingly distinctive period piece like no other. Telling a story steeped in folk horror, and featuring another strikingly memorable performance from Caleb Landry Jones (Nitram), Tsangari presents a study of superstition, the trauma of modernity, and the looming threat of the outsider.

BRING HER BACK (18)

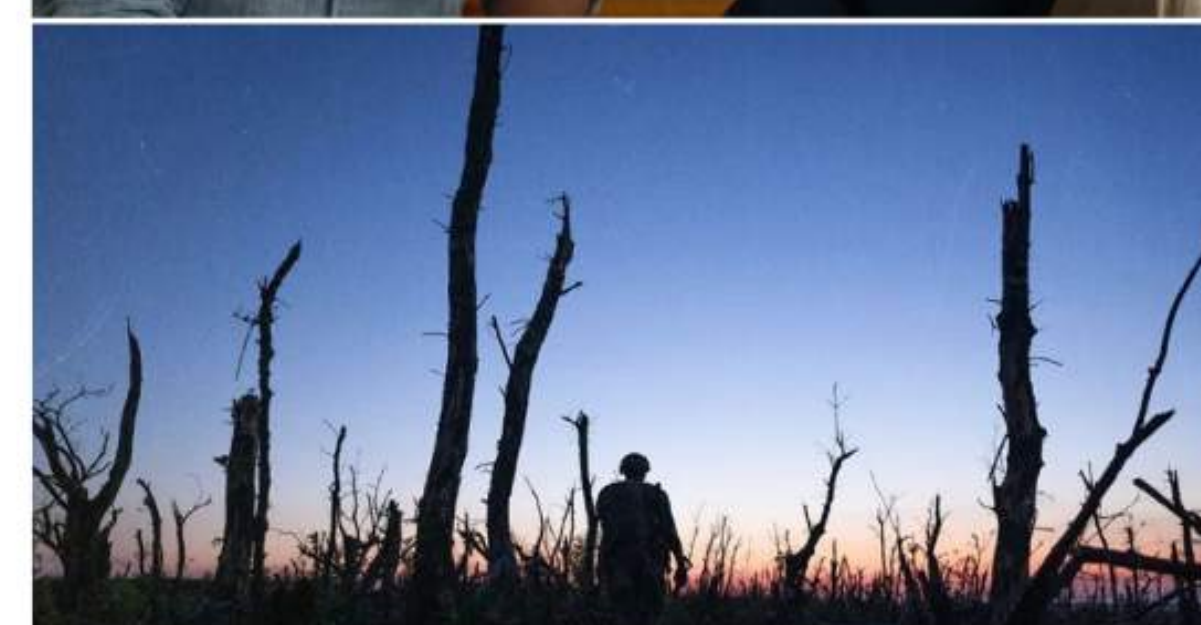
