ROSE OF NEVADA (15)

Set in a remote Cornish fishing village, the film opens with the unexplained reappearance of the vessel Rose of Nevada thought lost three decades prior. What follows is less a conventional mystery than a haunting, trance-like excavation of time, memory, and collective disquiet, rendered in Mark Jenkin's unmistakable visual and aural languages. Starring George MacKay and Callum Turner.



HOPPERS (U)

Scientists have discovered how to "hop" human consciousness into lifelike robotic animals, allowing people to communicate with animals as animals. Animal lover Mabel seizes an opportunity to use the technology, uncovering mysteries within the animal world that are beyond anything she could have imagined.



MIROIRS NO.3 (15)

On a remote German country-road, Laura survives a car crash that kills her partner. Though unharmed, she is in a quasi-catatonic daze. Taken in by Betty, an older local woman, Laura becomes a willing blank canvas onto which the stranger dotes her motherly care. *German with English subtitles.*



THE STRANGER (15)

François Ozon returns with a career-best work, an exquisite adaptation of Albert Camus's classic existential novel, which premiered in competition at the Venice Film Festival. Shot in crisp black and white, the film is a masterful interpretation, reconstituting some of the novel's themes for the modern era. *French with English subtitles.*

Steven Spielberg's sci-fi classic stars Richard Dreyfuss as a man who has a life-changing experience.
